FREDDIE MERCURY

Part 1

He was born on September 5th, 1946 in Stone Town, Zanzibar. His real name was Farrokh Bulsara, but he changed it to Freddie early in his life, because Freddie was an easier name to use.



He grew up in India, near Bombay. Later on, in 1964, he moved to London and went to London University, where he studied Graphic Art and Design. After his graduation, he started his musical career in small rock bands in London. He learned the piano and the guitar, even he didn't think he was good at them.

Part 2

In 1970, when he was in High School, he met Brian May and Roger Taylor. They formed the band Queen. He had been writing music for years, and became the lead singer in this band. With the other members of the band, they composed many chart-topping hits like "We are the Champions", "We will rock you", or "Bohemian Rhapsody". He was famous for his flamboyant stage persona, and his impressive four-octave vocal range.



Part 3

He had a long-lasting relationship with Mary Austin, which started in 1970. She was the woman who stood by his side for his entire life, even after they broke up.

Later on, he had an affair with a man, which led to his break up with Austin. He was now openly bisexual.

He had a chaotic personal life. As a consequence, he quit the band to launch a solo career which was not as successful as Queen's.

Part 4

In 1987, he was diagnosed with AIDS, but he only revealed this fact to his close family and friends. His stage appearances became rare, due to his growing illness. He made his last public appearance in 1990, the day when the band received a Brit Award in celebration of their outstanding career. Shortly after, on November 23rd 1991, his doctor finally announced to the press that he had been suffering from AIDS for the last 4 years.

He died the day after, on November 24th, 1991.

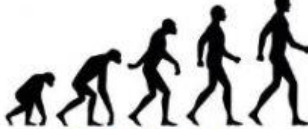

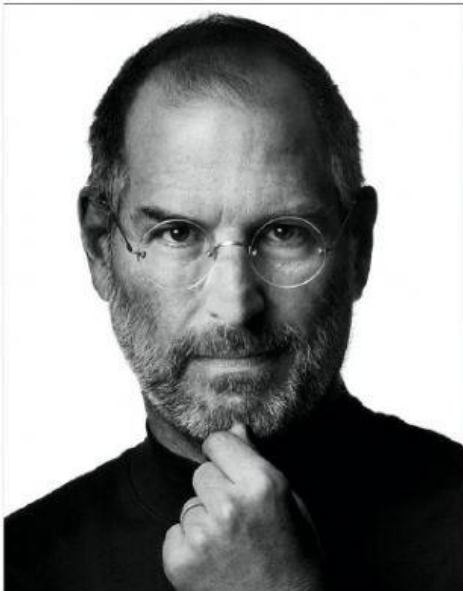
