**\*\* 경험 묻고 답하기**

- 의미: ‘...에 가본적이 있느냐’ : “Have you (ever) been to...?”  
‘...을 해본적이 있느냐’ : “Have you (ever) done...?”
- 대답: Yes, I have. / No, I haven't. (=have not)

ex) A: Have you ever been to Brazil?

(당신은 브라질 다녀온적이 있나요?)

B: Yes, I have. (예, 나는 다녀온적이 있어요)

/ No, I haven't. (아니요, 나는 다녀온적이 없어요.)
