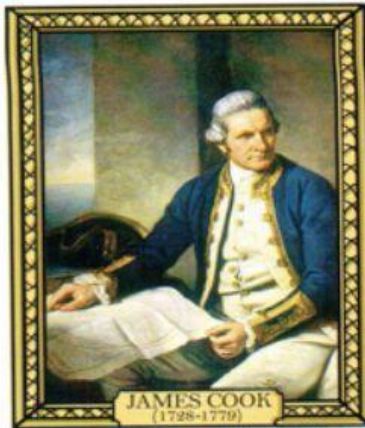


## I. Practise speaking for 15 seconds



First, match each portrait with the right information card.



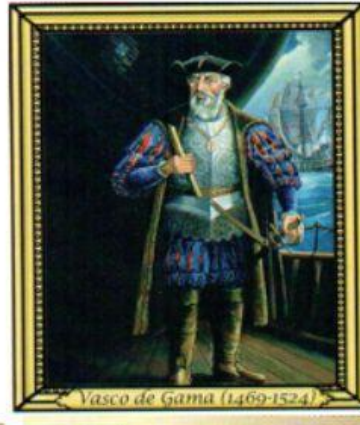
- Portuguese navigator.
