| I / You         | play  | football on Saturdays. |
| He / She / It   | plays |                        |
| We / You / They | play  |                        |

You play > vosotr"s jugáis

They play > ell@s juegan

He plays > él juega

She plays > ella juega

It plays > eso juega

"My brother is two. He **doesn't go** to school."

| negative        |         |                     |
|-----------------|---------|---------------------|
| I / You         | don't   | have lunch at home. |
| He / She / It   | doesn't |                     |
| We / You / They | don't   |                     |

**Cuidado!! Para decir que no se hace algo en inglés hay que usar el verbo "do" + "not" en sus dos formas: "do+ not" y "does+ not"**

**Ejemplo :**

Yo juego > I play      yo no juego > I do not play

Él juega > he plays      él no juega > he does not play

*"We **usually** sleep in the afternoon."*

always   usually   often   sometimes   never

I **often** play with my little brother.

I'm **never** late for English class.

**Cuidado!!!!!! Para expresar la frecuencia se ponen estos adverbios delante del verbo**

Always= siempre      Usually=normalmente      often = a menudo

Sometimes= a veces      never = nunca
