Staying home during quarantine is a good decision.

Not tipping in a restaurant can be considered bad manners.

David is in charge of <u>organizing</u> the party

You can get the virus for <u>not washing</u> your hands.

3. After <u>GO</u>, usually with recreational activities

I usually go fishing when I have free time.

My sister loves to go shopping.
