USE GERUND (verb + ing)

1. When a verb is used as a NOUN to begin a sentence:

Staying home during quarantine is a good decision.

Not tipping in a restaurant can be considered bad manners.

2. After PREPOSITIONS:

David is in charge of organizing the party

You can get the virus for not washing your hands.

3. After GO, usually with recreational activities

I usually go fishing when I have free time.

My sister loves to go shopping.
