1. In the ancient world, people didn't live long. Life was very hard in the past. In ancient Egypt, most people lived only to be 30 years old; and, in ancient China people died between the ages of 22-35. For this reason, they got married at the age of 14.
2. In ancient Egypt, people used to eat with their hands. After eating, they washed their hands, of course! It wasn't common to use forks. Forks became popular in Europe later, in the 10<sup>th</sup> century.
3. Pets in ancient Egypt could be common pets like dogs or cats, but they also had lions, monkeys and birds like falcons. Kids used to play with all kinds of pets. They also were in charge of taking care of them.
4. There were cosmetics about 5000 years ago. In ancient Egypt, women, men and children wore make-up because it was very important to look great and to be beautiful. Eye make-up was very popular and green and black were two of the Egyptians' favorite colors. Romans also wore make-up. Some make-up in the past was poisonous!

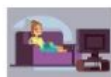
