Cheetahs are different from other wild cats, with their small heads, and long legs for sprinting. Their <u>stare</u> makes them look frightening, but these proud <u>predators</u> are actually quite <u>timid</u>.

At one time cheetahs used to live throughout Africa and as far east as India. Today, their numbers have <u>decreased</u> to the extent that they are mainly found in national parks in Eastern and Southern Africa, having almost disappeared from Northern and Western Africa. The few that remain in Asia are <u>primarily</u> found in Iran. The <u>declining</u> numbers of cheetahs could be the result of the high <u>demand</u> for their spotted coats.

Cheetahs are not as <u>aggressive</u> as other wild cats: they are afraid of humans and will run away from leopards and lions. In fact, they hunt during the late morning or early afternoon to <u>avoid</u> their <u>enemies</u>.

Cheetahs are well known for their <u>agility</u> and the high speed at which they <u>pursue</u> their <u>prey</u>. However, they can only run at top speed for a few seconds because their bodies become quickly overheated.
