

İngilizce'de "Modals" bir eylem veya gerçek hakkında farklı kesinlik derecelerini ifade edebilir. Must, could, might, may, will, shall, couldn't ve can't konuşmacının mevcut bir durumun ne kadar olası veya muhtemel olduğunu göstermek için kullandığı Modal'lardır.

- **Kesinlik:** "Will, shall, can" ve "must" Modal'ları kesinliği ifade etmek için kullanılır.
 - You must be joking. (Şaka yaptığından eminim)
 - There is the doorbell. That will be the postman. (Postacı olduğuna eminim)
 - That can't be the milkman. He has already been. (Onun sütçü olmadığından eminim)
- **Olasılık ve İhtimal:** "Should" ve "may" olasılık veya ihtimali ifade etmek için kullanılır.
 - He should be here soon. (Olası, kesin değil)
 - They may be taking a long leave.
- **Zayıf olasılık:** Zayıf olasılığı ifade etmek için "might" veya "could" kullanılır.
 - She might win.
 - I could be a millionaire one day.
- **Teorik veya ahsilmiş olasılık:** Teorik olasılığı ifade etmek için "can" kullanılır.
 - Glass can be blown.
 - Dubai can be very warm in April and May.
