We used to + the base form of a verb for past habits or situations that are different now.

For example:

- He used to have a lot of free time to play, but now he work.
- I used to play tennis, but I don't anymore.
- They used to take the bus to house, but now the drive the motorcycle.

Affirmative statements

- I/ You/ She/ He/ We/ They used to drive to Berlin.

Negative statements

- I/ You/ She/ He/ We/ They didn't use to draw a flower.

Wh-questions

- Where did I/ You/ She/ He/ We/ They use to live?
