Remember: Adverbs of manner describe **HOW** (¿Cómo?) things happen.

How do we form adverbs of manner?

✎ They are usually formed by **adding -ly** at the end of the **adjectives**.

slow → slowly beautiful → beautifully

✎ Sometimes there are **changes in spelling** when the adjective **ends in -y** or when the adjective **ends in -e**:

happy → happily
easy → easily

horrible → horribly
terrible → terriblly

✎ And there are some **irregular adverbs**:

good → well

fast → fast
