

İngilizce'de birçok zarf, sıfat'ın sonuna "-ly" eklenmesiyle oluşur ancak bu kurala uymayan zarflar da vardır. Bunlar:

GOOD / WELL: My mother is a good cook. She cooks well

FAST, HARD, LATE, EARLY: Bu sözcüklerin sıfat ve zarf biçimi aynıdır.

He is a fast runner. (adj) ---- He runs fast. (adv)

He is a hard worker. (adj) ---- He works hard. (adv)

I have to catch the early train. (adj) ---- I have to leave early (adv)

Don't panic, we can catch the late train. (adj) ---She left home late (adv)

Bu sözcüklere "-ly" eklendiğinde başka anlam kazanırlar

- **LATE:** Geç **LATELY:** son zamanlarda

- **HARD:** çok yoğun **HARDLY:** neredeyse hiç, güçlükle
