### Explanations:

- 1. Wedding ceremony / wedding reception. Antennas for TV reception.**
- 2. A set of jumper cables is used to start a car with a flat battery. To start something is to cause trouble.**
- 3. Two meanings of funny - funny = odd / funny = humorous (like a clown)**
- 4. Nothing to look at means quite plain or ugly. If something is invisible there is nothing to look at.**
- 5. To camouflage is to make something difficult to see.**
- 6. Dam = Damn!**
