REMEMBER!

## Regular verbs:

**Positive:**  + verb(ed/d) → He liked chocolate.


**Negative:**  + didn't+verb (infinitive) → He didn't like chocolate.

**Questions:** (Wh) Did+  + verb (infinitive)? → Did he like chocolate? / What did he like?

## Irregular verbs:

**Positive:**  + verb (2nd column) → He went to the park.

**Negative:**  + didn't+ verb (infinitive) → He didn't go to the park.

**Questions:** (Wh) Did+  + verb (infinitive)? → Did he go to the park? / Where did he go?
