




# Comparative and superlative

price : £15,000  
speed: 110 mph  
size: medium  
petrol consumption: average  
made in 2001

**John's**



price : £7,000  
speed: 90 mph  
size: small  
petrol consumption: low  
made in 1987

**Carol's**



price : £19,000  
speed: 130 mph  
size: large  
petrol consumption: high  
made in 2006
