To compare 2 things:
SHORT ADJECTIVES
adjective + ER + THAN

To compare 2:
LONG ADJECTIVES
MORE + adjective + THAN

To compare more than 2:
SHORT ADJECTIVES
THE + adjective + EST

To compare more than 2:
LONG ADJECTIVES
THE + MOST + adjective

REMEMBER!

- ✚ Adjectives ending in **-e** add **-r** / **-st**. For example: finer, safest, larger
- ✚ Adjectives ending in **consonant + y** lose **y** and add **-ier** / **-iest**. For example: lovelier, luckiest, prettier
- ✚ Adjectives ending in a **single vowel + single consonant** double the consonant. For example: fitter, sadder, thinner, wettest, hottest
