- Arrow 5 points to the first square of the horizontal word 5.
- Arrow 6 points to the first square of the horizontal word 6.
- Arrow 7 points to the first square of the horizontal word 7.
- Arrow 8 points to the first square of the horizontal word 8.
- Arrow 9 points to the first square of the horizontal word 9.
- Arrow 10 points to the first square of the horizontal word 10.
- Arrow 11 points to the first square of the horizontal word 11.
