AROUND CHILDREN:

- 1) WHEN DRIVING WITHIN 500 TO 1,000 FEET OF A SCHOOL WHILE CHILDREN ARE _____ OR CROSSING THE STREET, THE SPEED LIMIT IS 25 MPH UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED.
- 2) ALSO, IF THE SCHOOL GROUNDS HAVE NO FENCE AND CHILDREN ARE OUTSIDE, NEVER DRIVE _____ THAN 25 MPH.
- 3) SOME SCHOOL ZONES MAY HAVE SPEED LIMITS AS LOW AS 15 MPH.

- SOME SCHOOL _____ FLASH YELLOW LIGHTS WHEN PREPARING TO STOP TO LET CHILDREN OFF THE BUS.
- THE _____ FLASHING LIGHTS WARN YOU TO SLOW DOWN AND PREPARE TO STOP.
- WHEN THE BUS FLASHES RED LIGHTS (LOCATED AT THE TOP FRONT AND BACK OF THE BUS), YOU MUST STOP FROM _____ DIRECTION UNTIL THE CHILDREN ARE SAFELY ACROSS THE STREET AND LIGHTS STOP FLASHING.
- THE LAW REQUIRES YOU _____ STOPPED AS LONG AS THE RED LIGHTS ARE FLASHING.
- IF YOU FAIL TO STOP, YOU MAY BE _____ UP TO \$1000 AND YOUR DRIVING PRIVILEGE COULD BE SUSPENDED FOR 1 YEAR.
- IF THE SCHOOL BUS IS ON THE OTHER SIDE OF A DIVIDED OR _____ HIGHWAY (TWO OR MORE LANES IN EACH DIRECTION), YOU DO NOT NEED TO STOP.
