

- PHRASAL VERBS

LOOK FORWARD TO

(Transitive)



= to be eagerly waiting for something pleasant

This phrasal verb is used when a person feels happy or excited about something that is going to happen. The person is eagerly waiting for a pleasant event.



Look forward to + **object** (something)

Look forward to + **verb-ing** (action)

 - I'm looking forward to my birthday. ✓
 - I'm looking forward to seeing you again. ✓
 - I'm looking forward to what? ✗ (incomplete sentence)

Looking forward to **what?**
We need more information.

EXAMPLE SENTENCES

 - Jennifer is really **looking forward to** her wedding day.
 - Are you **looking forward to** your vacation?
 - I'm really **looking forward to** working with you.
 - I **look forward to** your response.
