BIG BEN

You probably recognize Big Ben, the clock tower at one end of the Houses of Parliament in London. Big Ben belongs to the House of Parliament. It's London's most famous monument. But perhaps you don't know Big Ben's real name : The Elizabeth Tower. Big Ben dates from 1859 . The tower is 96 metres high . There are 334 stairs in it, but tourists can't go inside the tower or climb to the top. There are four clock faces and each face is seven metres in diameter. The minute hands are 4.2 metres long and weigh about 100 kilos . The bell weighs about 13.760 kilos . Big Ben looks amazing at night because there are lights on the clock faces. On 31st December every year – New Year's Eve – TV stations in the UK show pictures of Big Ben at midnight . And all over the country people listen to the twelve chimes of the bell when the old year ends.
