BLIND INTERSECTIONS:

- 1) THE SPEED LIMIT FOR A BLIND _____ IS 15 MPH.
- 2) AN INTERSECTION IS CONSIDERED “_____” IF THERE IS NO STOP SIGNS AT ANY CORNER AND YOU CANNOT SEE FOR 100 FEET IN EITHER DIRECTION DURING THE LAST 100 FEET BEFORE CROSSING.
- 3) IF YOUR VIEW IS _____, MOVE SLOWLY FORWARD UNTIL YOU CAN SEE.

ALLEYS:

- 1) THE SPEED LIMIT IN AN _____ IS 15 MPH.

NEAR RAILROAD TRACKS:

- 1) THE SPEED LIMIT IS 15 MPH WITHIN 100 FEET OF A RAILROAD _____ WHERE YOU CANNOT SEE THE TRACKS FOR 400 FEET IN BOTH DIRECTIONS.
- 2) YOU MAY _____ FASTER THAN 15 MPH IF THE CROSSING IS CONTROLLED BY GATES, A WARNING SIGNAL, OR A FLAGMAN.
