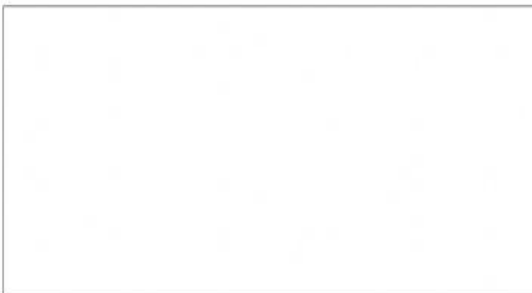
3) What do these phrases mean? Choose ALL the correct answers.
