## No change in Eurozone rates

■ The European Central Bank has left interest rates unchanged despite worries over the German economy. The last time there was a fall <sup>1</sup> ..... interest rates was on 10 May, when the bank announced a cut <sup>2</sup> ..... 0.25%, bringing the key interest rate for the Eurozone countries to 4.5%. The decision came hours after official figures showed a surprising increase <sup>3</sup> ..... unemployment in Germany. Analysts had been forecasting a rise



<sup>4</sup> ..... 5,500 but the official figures reported an increase <sup>5</sup> ..... 18,000, taking the total to just under four million. The ECB is also facing the problem

of a sharp increase <sup>6</sup> ..... Eurozone inflation. The increase <sup>7</sup> ..... 0.3% has pushed the annual rate to 2.9%, compared with a target of 2%.
