



## Let's revise the rule

### The present continuous affirmative



#### Affirmative

I am playing  
you are playing  
he is playing  
she is playing  
it is playing  
we are playing  
you are playing  
they are playing

#### Short forms

I'm playing  
you're playing  
he's playing  
she's playing  
it's playing  
we're playing  
you're playing  
they're playing

We don't use short forms after two names.

Eric and Charlie **are playing** volleyball.

BUT

**They're playing** volleyball

**John's playing** volleyball.

We use the present continuous to talk about:

- Something that is happening at the moment we are speaking.

*She's talking to someone on the phone at the moment.*

### The present continuous negative



#### Negative

I am not playing  
you are not playing  
he is not playing  
she is not playing  
it is not playing  
we are not playing  
you are not playing  
they are not playing

#### Short forms

I'm not playing  
you aren't playing  
he isn't playing  
she isn't playing  
it isn't playing  
we aren't playing  
you aren't playing  
they aren't playing
