Spelling Rules	Examples
Add ed to most verbs	cook – cooked paint – painted
Ending in e add d	live – lived stare – stared
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add ed	try – tried carry – carried
One syllable verbs ending in Consonant - Vowel - Consonant , double the last consonant and add ed	plan – planned stop – stopped rip – ripped
