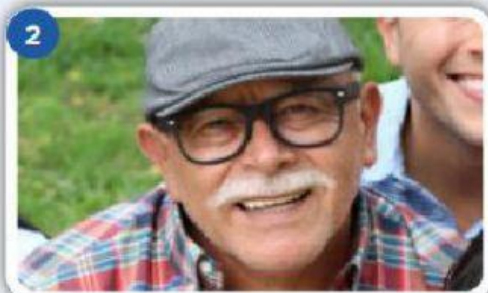

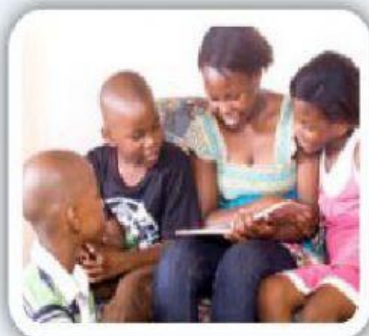

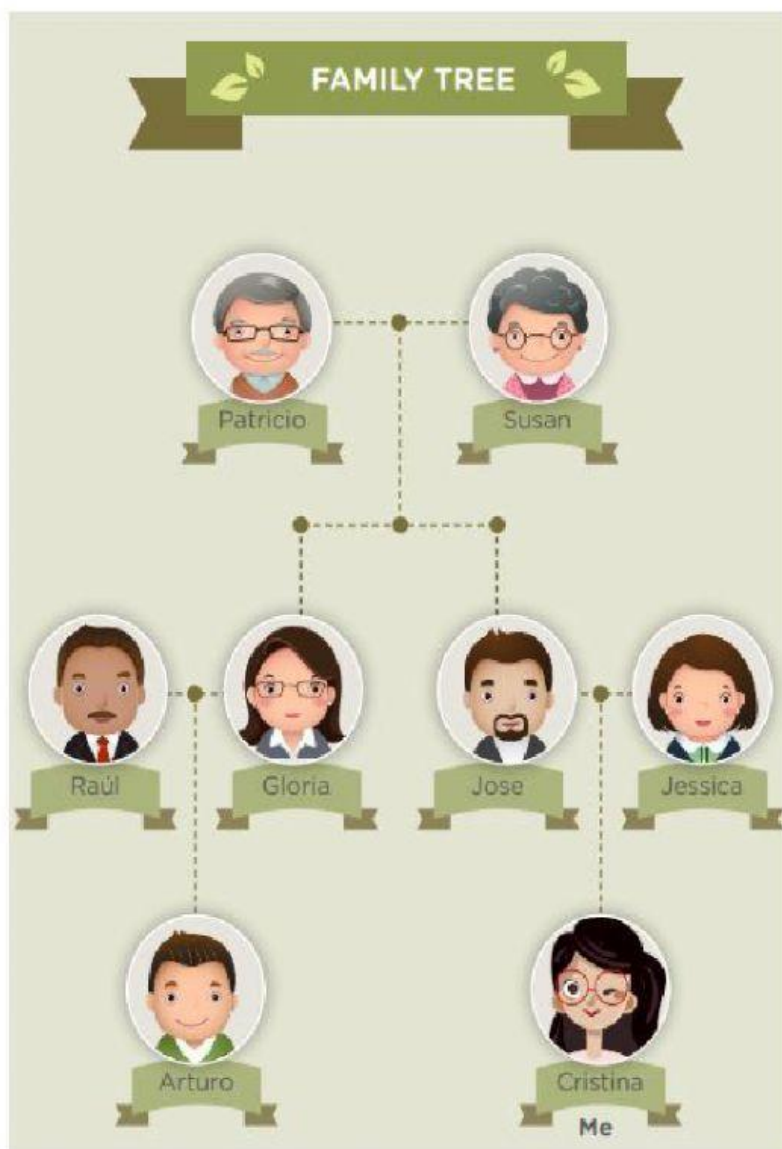
- We use "Who's" to ask about people.

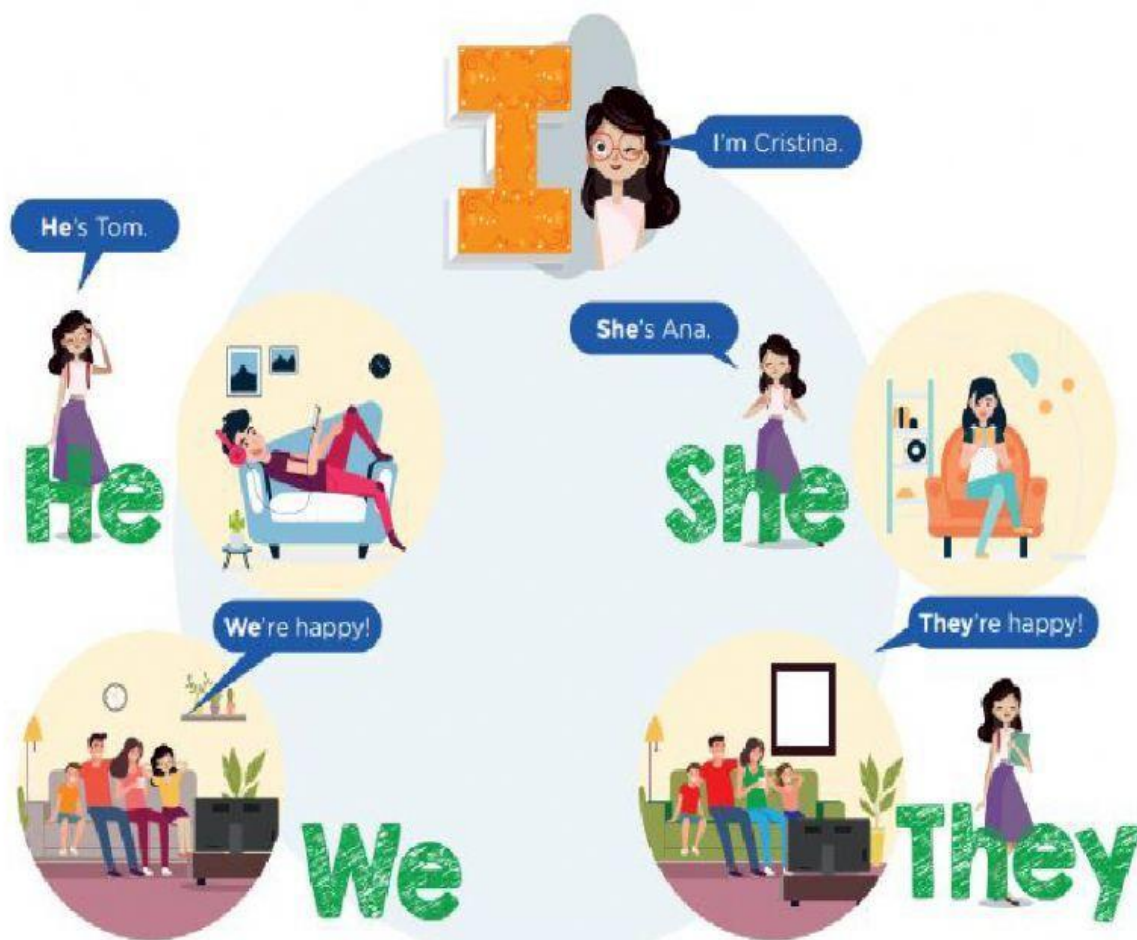
