CYTOPLASM

- 1. In animal cells, a thick, clear liquid protected by the membrane.
- Part of a cell that controls everything that happens inside the cell and its activities.
- Name of the organelles that are inside the cytoplasm of plant cells.
- Storage bubbles that contain water and nutrients or, sometimes, waste products.
- 5. Group of organs that work together to perform a function.
