Treasure Hunts

Participating in a treasure hunt needs observation (0) or skill. After the treasure is hidden, the hunters are given clues that will help (1) us find the treasure. In a simple treasure hunt, the hunters only need to (2) finding the treasure as quickly as possible. The hunter who finds the treasure first (3) was the winner. In a more complex treasure hunt, the clues carry points. The more difficult clues will carry more points than the (4) easy ones. The clues are written in such a way that some skill is (5) need to understand them. The hunter (6) whom locates the treasure first need not necessarily be the winner. Usually, the winner must (7) achieves the highest points from the clues. Clues that carry points may be questions that require the hunters to answer (8) correct or they may be items that need to be collected and handed in with the treasure.
