EXAMPLES:

During the lockdown...

- ✓ You **can** read a book at home.
- ✓ You **can** study from home



You use **CAN'T** for actions you are prohibited to do

EXAMPLES:

During the lockdown...

- ✓ You **can't** go outside without a mask.
- ✓ Students **can't** go to school.



You use **CAN** to describe abilities

EXAMPLES:

- ✓ Birds **can** sing.
- ✓ Inés Melchor **can** run very fast.
- ✓ Your friend **can** swim.



You use **CAN'T** to describe that you don't have a certain ability

EXAMPLES:

- ✓ I **can't** play the guitar
- ✓ You **can't** speak Chinese
- ✓ Babies **can't** cook
