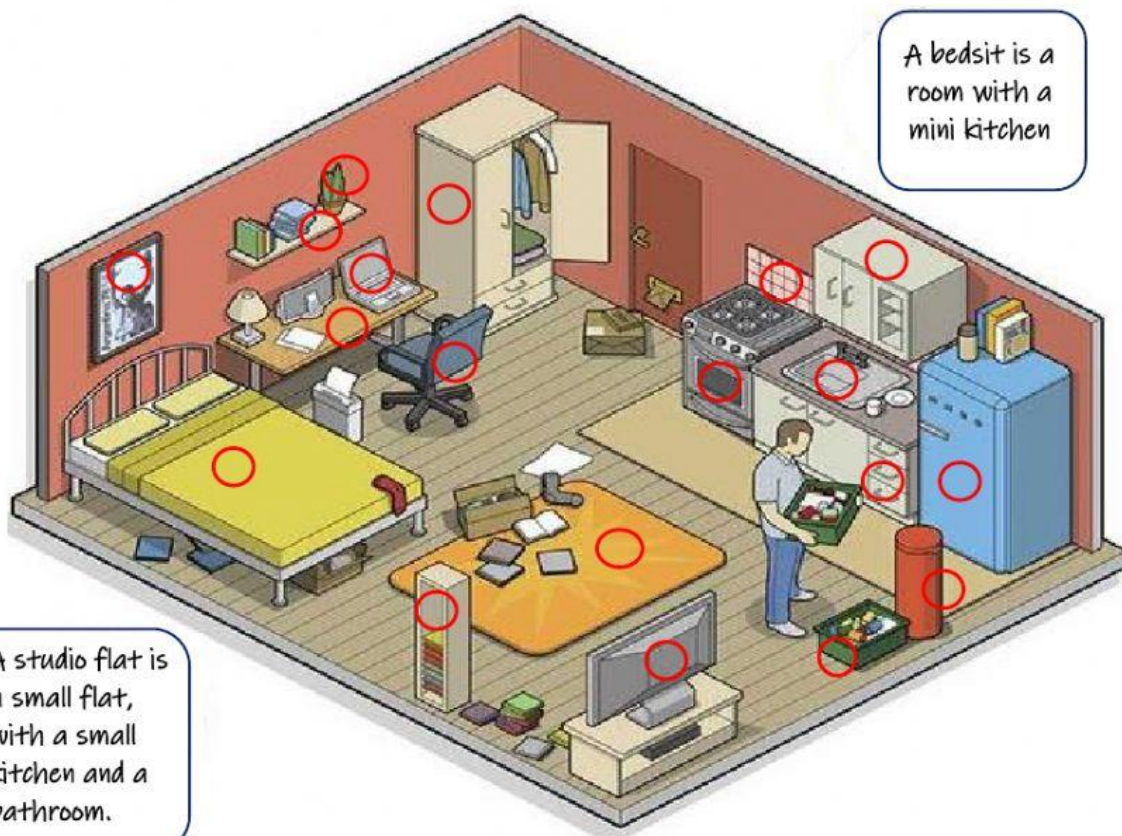


Gregory's bedsit
