 Question tags- are short questions at the end of the statements.
 e.g. David studies German, doen't he?
 Christine can't speak German, can she?

 FORM


 Question tags: auxiliary or modal verb (from the main sentence) + subject pronoun
 it refers to the subject of the main sentence


 > When the verb of the sentence is in the present simple, we form the question tag with dol does.
 e.g. Your parents work very hard, don't they?

 > When the verb of the sentence is in the past simple, we form the question tag with did.
 e.g. They won the match, didn't they?

 > When the sentence is affirmative, the question tag is negative.
 e.g. You have read this book, haven't you?

 affirmative verb negative, the question tag is positive.
 e.g. You didn't call me yesterday, did you?
 negative verb affirmative question tag
