

## ALL ABOUT QUEEN AND FREDDIE MERCURY

'Sheer Heart Attack' and 'A Night At The Opera' followed, the former bearing '\_\_\_killer\_\_\_ (kill) Queen', the \_\_\_later\_\_\_ (late) 'Bohemian Rhapsody'. This epic \_\_\_\_\_ (sing) was a record breaker, remaining the \_\_\_\_\_ (long) running number one for twenty years.
