

### COMPARATIVE

Comparative adjectives are used to compare differences between the two objects they modify (*larger, smaller, faster, higher*). They are used in sentences where two nouns are compared.

#### Short adjectives

**Subject + verb TO BE + adjective –ER + THAN + complements**

*My father is taller than your mother*

*Dogs are faster than cats*

#### Long adjectives

**Subject + verb TO BE + MORE + adjective + THAN + complements**

*You are more intelligent than your brother*

*Lions are more dangerous than horses*

### SUPERLATIVE

Superlative adjectives are used to describe an object which is at the upper or lower limit of a quality (*the tallest, the smallest, the fastest, the highest*). They are used in sentences where a subject is compared to a group of objects.

#### Short adjectives

**Subject + verb TO BE + THE + adj –EST + complements**

*This exercise is the easiest in the exam*

*Elephants are the strongest animals in the savannah*

#### Long adjectives

**Subject + verb TO BE + THE + MOST + adj + complements**

*This sofa is the most comfortable in the shop*

*Laura is the most beautiful girl in the country*

### IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES

	Comparative	Superlative
<b>Good</b>	better	the best
<b>Bad</b>	worse	the worst
<b>Far</b>	farther	the farthest

*This exam is the worst in the school year*

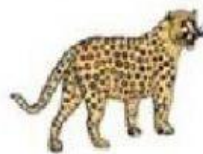

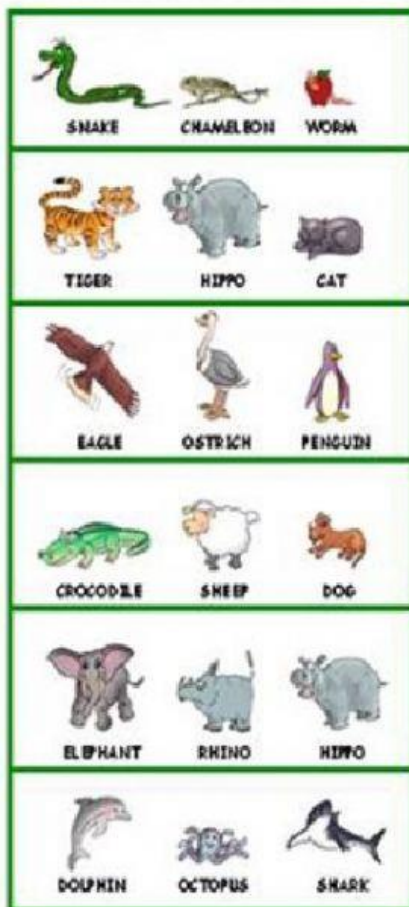
