

CONDITIONALS TOGETHER

Zero Conditional – Facts and Routines

If + present simple + present simple e.g. If/When it is hot, we turn on the air-conditioning.

1st Conditional – Present and Future possible/likely situations

If + present simple + will + infinitive e.g. If it is sunny tomorrow, we'll go for a picnic.

2nd Conditional – Present and Future impossible/unlikely situations

If + past simple + would + infinitive e.g. If you weren't lazy, you'd have better results.

3rd Conditional – Past situations (hypothetical)

If + past perfect + would + have past participle e.g. If I hadn't hit your car, we would never have met.
