

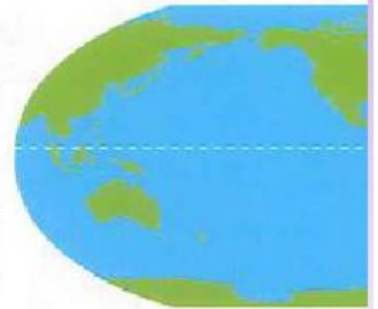

The Earth is not perfectly round. The planet bulges a little bit at the equator. Mt Chimborazo, in Ecuador, is 6,268 m (20,565 ft) high and very near the equator. That means its peak is closer to the Moon and farther from the centre of the Earth than anywhere else on Earth.

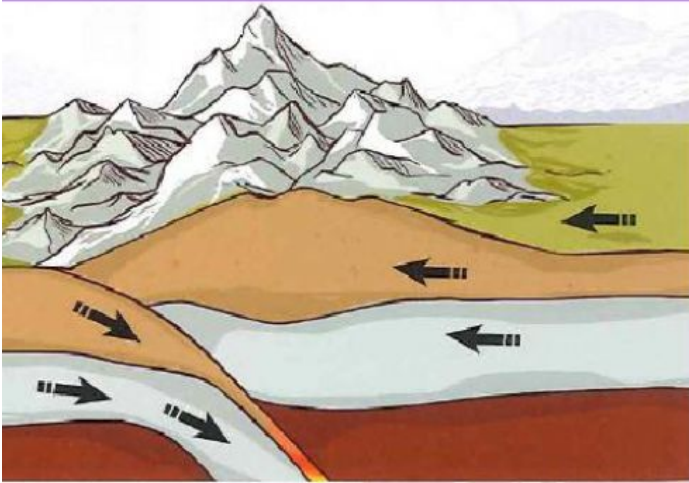
