Some deserts even have occasional snowstorms.

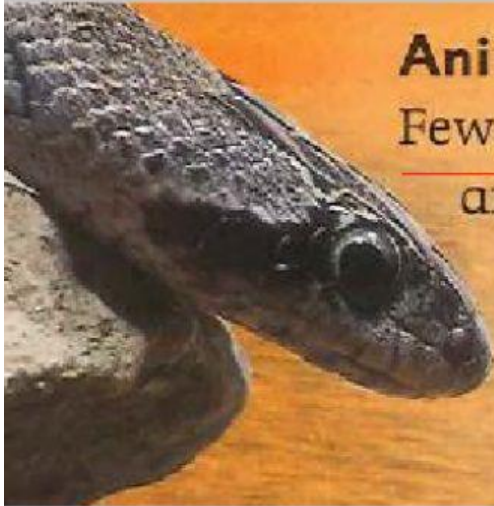

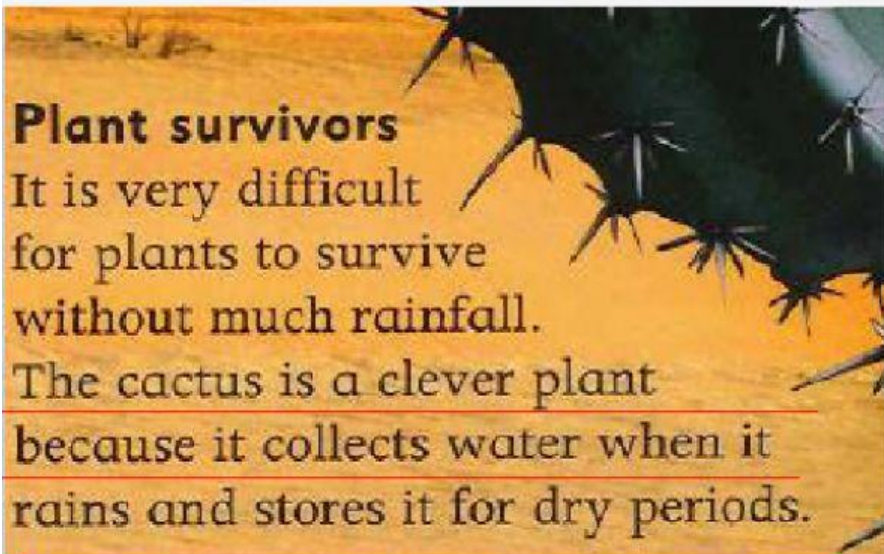
