- **Expressing obligation with have to / has to + verb in infinitive**
- **Expressing lack of obligation (no obligation) with don't have to / doesn't have to + verb in infinitive**
- **Expressing prohibition with can't / cannot + verb in infinitive**

Ex. 2: Complete the following sentences with have to – has to – don't have to – doesn't have to – can (possibility) – can't (prohibition).

<b>have to</b>	I <b>have to work</b> late again tonight, unfortunately. Do you <b>have to take</b> the bus today? Yes, I <b>do</b> . / No, I <b>don't</b> .	Jackie <b>has to study</b> math in school. Does he <b>have to wait</b> a long time? Yes, he <b>does</b> . / No, he <b>doesn't</b> .
<b>not have to</b>	You <b>don't have to pay</b> – it's free!	He <b>doesn't have to wear</b> a uniform to school.
<b>can't</b>	I <b>can't be</b> late for the meeting.	Luke <b>can't eat</b> too much salt.

**Look!** Remember, *can't* and *don't have to* have different meanings.

*You can't walk on the grass.* = It's not allowed.

*You don't have to walk on the grass – you can walk on the path.* = it's not necessary. You can choose.
