

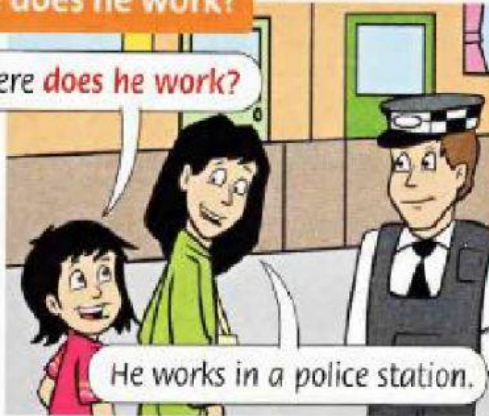


Where does he work?

He works in a police station.

She works in a hospital.



Where does he work? is a wh- question. We use **where** to ask about a place. We use **does** to make questions with **he**, **she** and **it** in the present simple. The word order changes in questions.

Statement

He works ...

She works ...

It works ...

Question

Where **does** he work?

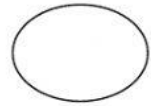
