The Cave of the Crystals

The Mexican state of Chihuahua is home to one of the (1).....(**NATURE**) wonders of the world - The Cave of the Crystals. Discovered (2).....(**ACCIDENT**) in 2000 by miners drilling a tunnel, the cave lies about 350m below the surface of the Naica Mountains. It contains over 170 of the largest natural crystals ever found — one of them measures about 11m and weighs more than 5500kg.
