Yes, I am/ No, I'm not.
Yes, he is/ No, he isn't.
Yes, she is/ No, she isn't.
Yes, they are/ No, they aren't.
Yes, it is/ No, it isn't.
Yes, I am/ No, I'm not.

B: Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.




A: Is it time for lunch/dinner?
