Types of assessment Drag the words to the correct definition assessment - When a student's work is judged through a test and the student is given a report or a grade to say how successful or unsuccessful they have been. assessment - A type of testing which is different from a final examination. Some or all of the work that SUMMATIVE students do during a course is considered by the teacher on a regular basis and contributes to the final grade given to students. It may also include monitoring of classroom performance INFORMAL and contribution. assessment - when a test is used at the end of a course. A mark or grade is **FORMAL** given, but no other feedback. assessment - When students give feedback on each others' PEER language, work, learning strategies, performance assessment – When a teacher decides whether a student is doing well SELFor not but does not necessarily set a test or write an official report or give a grade assessment - A collection **PORTFOLIO** of work that a student uses to show what he/she has done during a particular course. A purposeful document, regularly added to that CONTINUOUS may be part of assessment. assessment - When a teacher gives students feedback on their progress during a course, rather than at the end **FORMATIVE** of it, so that they can learn from the feedback. assessment - When

students decide for themselves if they think their progress or language use is good or not.
