We use <u>past perfect</u> in the condition clause:  $\rightarrow$  if I <u>had skipped</u> breakfast...

And would have + verb -ed/3<sup>rd</sup> column in the result clause  $\rightarrow$  ... I <u>wouldn't have arrived</u> late to school.
