

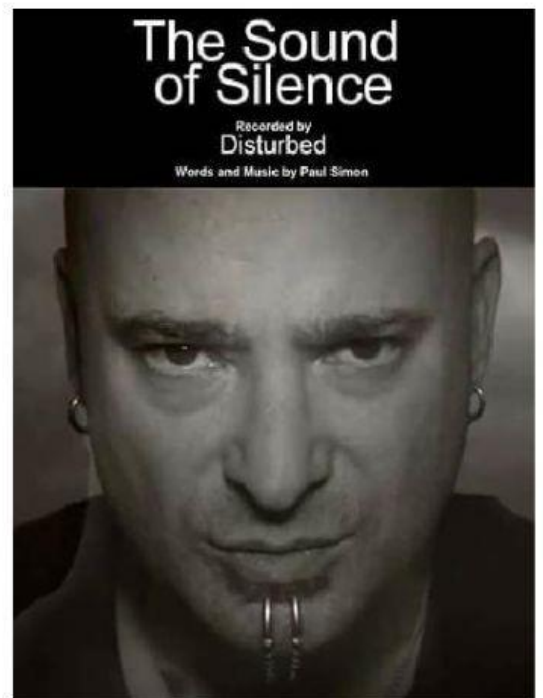
The Sound of Silence
