

LISTENING PRACTICE -- TRAVELING

I. When we talk about traveling we frequently use the verb "stay". "Stay" can mean different things, for example: **1) to visit**, or **2) to sleep in a hotel or a friend's house**.

Example #1 -- How long did you **stay** in New York? I **stayed** in New York for one week.

Example #2 -- Where did you stay? I stayed in a hotel for 2 nights and at my cousin's house for 5 nights.

Example #3 -- When you come to Seattle, do you want to stay at my house? (Do you want to sleep at my house?)
