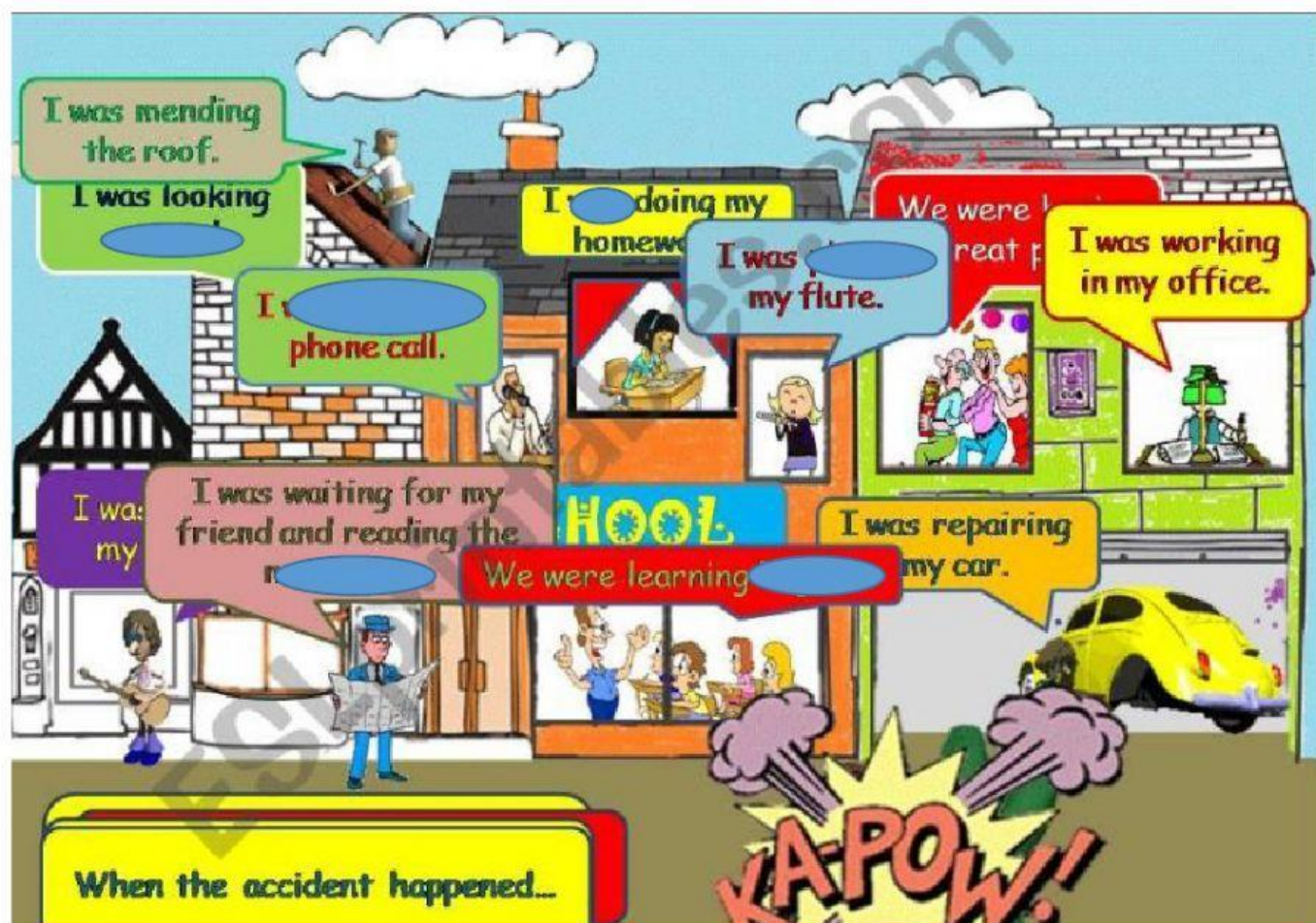

Notice! What do the sentences have in common? Choose

1(they all have the verb to be + Verb ing)

2(they all have Verb-ing)

Affirmative	<p>S + was/were + V-ing</p> <p>She was cooking all the morning.</p>
Negative	<p>S + was/were + not + V-ing</p> <p>She was not sleeping when he came home.</p>
Interrogative	<p>Was/were + S + V-ing</p> <p>Was she sleeping when he came home?</p>
