A. Future: Affirmatives and Negatives

Affirmative	Negative
We Students will read tomorrow. John	We Students will not read tomorrow. John
It will be cloudy tomorrow.	It won't be cloudy tomorrow.

- **will + verb (simple form):** (I) will go (X) will goes
(I) will be (X) will am/is/are

- **Contractions:**

- **Will** can be contracted with subject pronouns: I'll You'll He'll She'll It'll We'll They'll
- **won't = will + not**
