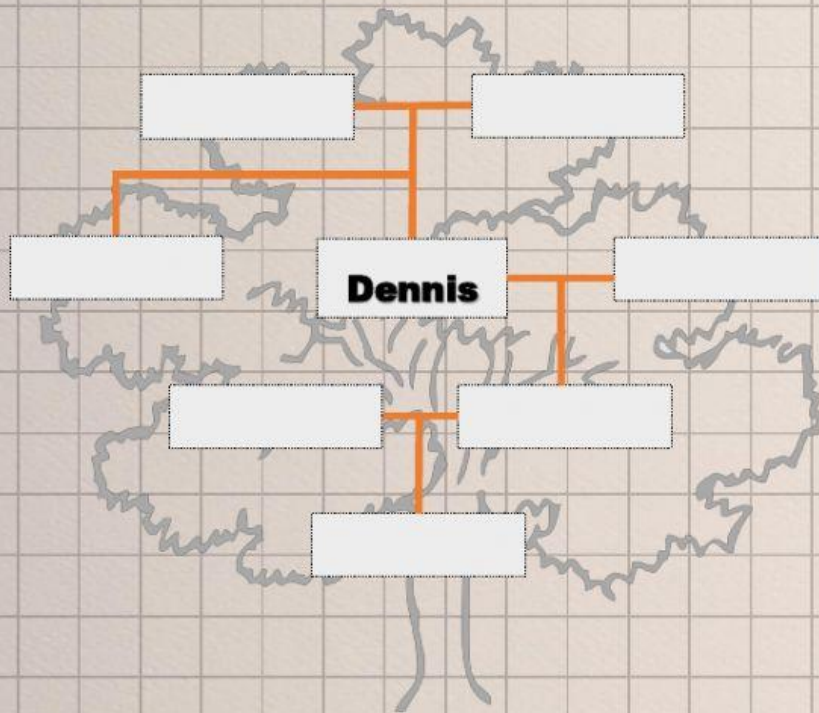


## FIRST CYCLE FINAL TEST

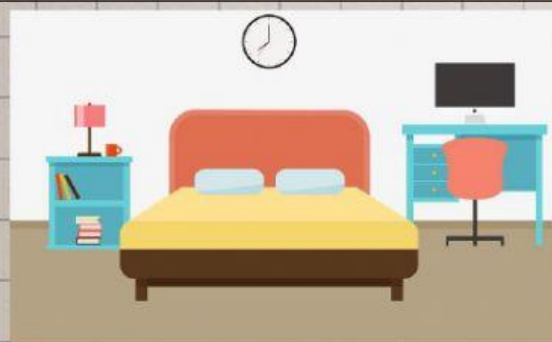
