## FACT

- A fact is something you can **prove** to be either true or false.
- You **cannot change** a fact.



## OPINION

- An opinion is how a **person or thing feels** about something.
- You **can change** an opinion.

### The passive: Simple present

#### Affirmative and negative

##### Affirmative

Pedro's T-shirt **is made** from cotton.

The T-shirts **are transported** on ships.

##### Negative

It **isn't recycled**.

Workers **aren't paid** much.
