

JOSÉ DE SAN MARTIN

1. San Martin was born in Yapeyú, a small town in the province of Corrientes, on February 25th, 1778.
2. When he was 3 years old, he travelled to Spain by ship, with his family.
3. He studied to be a military man..
4. In 1812 he returned to Buenos Aires to join the forces fighting for liberation.
5. As a General for the Buenos Aires government, San Martin created an army called Mounted Grenadies.
6. At the age of 34 he married Remedios de Escalada. In August 24th, 1816, they had a daughter called Mercedes.
7. He then concentrated on freeing Chile and Perú. He crossed the Andes on foot in 1817.
8. His army easily conquered Peru and entered Lima in July 1821.
9. He met with his fellow liberator Simon Bolivar at Guayaquil in 1822.
10. He went into voluntary exile in Europe after his wife death in 1824.
11. He lived in France with his daughter Mercedes and wrote his well known maxims for her. He died in Bulogne-sur-mer on August 17th, 1850.
12. Since 1880 he rests in Buenos Aires Cathedral, in a special mausoleum.
