They **don't have to** wash their face.

You **don't have to** go to the pharmacy.

Gwen **doesn't have to** go to bed.

She **doesn't have to** go to school.

Nathan **doesn't have to** eat vegetables everyday.

He **doesn't have to** drink soda.
